Tribal Registration



He tono, he akiaki teenei i ngaa whaanau kia rehita i ngaa tamariki meenaa kaare anoo kia wheeraa.

Waikato Tainui provides numerous programmes and opportunities for our tamariki and rangatahi, including Young Engineers, Young Animators, Coding, Reo Aratau, Taster Courses, House of Science including programmes for whaanau. We have been fortunate to be able to get these at a subsidised rate.

In support of Waikato Tainui and our marae, who benefit from the number of tribal registrations, we are asking that all eligible whaanau check registrations and complete if not already done. The Education and Pathways team are also collating a database of numbers of participants in the various programmes so they can gauge coverage across marae. **At no time are any details, names etc of participants shared. Just the number of participants.**

Criteria for enrolment

1. You must be able to whakapapa to one of the 33 Hapuu and one of the 68 Marae listed on page 2 of this form.
2. You must complete all sections of this form.
3. You must also provide a copy of a valid identification e.g. Birth Certificate, Passport, Drivers Licence, Student ID, 18+ Card, Marriage Certificate.

Why should I enrol?

It identifies you as a member of Waikato-Tainui enabling 18+ members to vote on tribal matters.

You will financially support your principal Marae.

It allows you access to a range of grants and opportunities.

Stay up-to-date and informed about tribal matters.

Who should enrol?

Any person who can whakapapa to one of the 33 Hapuu and one of the 68 Marae listed on page 2 of the registration form.
